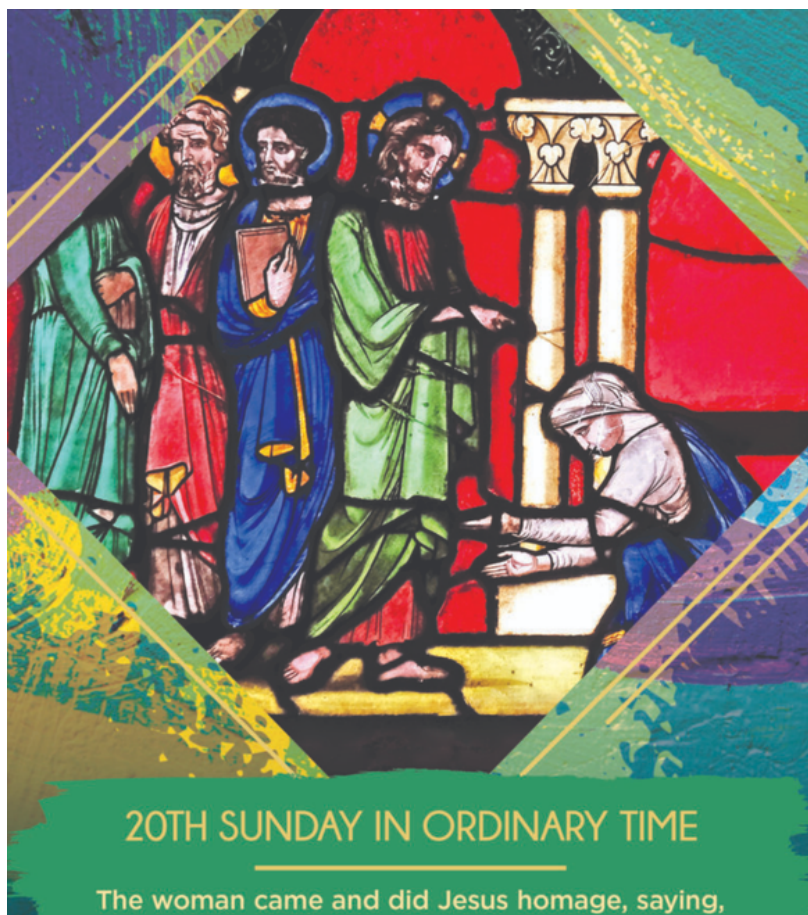

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As summer ends and fall returns, it is time to begin our Christian Formation program at St. Andre's. We would like to welcome all children, grades K-10. Second grade will focus on the Sacraments of Penance and First Communion. Ninth and tenth grades will focus on the Sacrament of Confirmation. There will be a fee (\$25 for 1-2 children, \$50 for 3 or more children) to cover the cost of materials and supplies.
